Shurtleff (Vols. 1-8) and David Pulsifer (Vols. 9-12), Editors, "Records of the Colony of New Plymouth In New England," 12 Vols. (issued bound as 9 or 10) (Boston: The Press of William White, Printer to the Commonwealth, 1855-1861; repr. in 6 Vols. New York: AMS Press, 1968), Vol. 1, p. 110. This marriage did not take place at Marshfield - that town was incorporated 01-Mar-1642. William lived at Duxbury from about 1638 to about 1644, but the Court record of his marriage does not specify location, and it may have taken place at Plymouth.

Is this the correct date of death of William, "The Pilgrim" - 25 Oct 1679.

The date of his death is not known. He was buried 25-Oct-1679 at Marshfield [Robert M. Sherman and Ruth Wilder Sherman, Editors, "Vital Records of Marshfield, Massachusetts to the Year 1850" (Warwick, RI: Society of Mayflower Descendants in the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, 1970; reprinted Camden, ME: Picton Press, 1993), p. 9].
